



## **Butterfly Venn Diagram**










Paul and his friends, Timothy and Silas, traveled throughout the country of Phrygia and Galatia. From town to town, they taught people about the gospel, the good news of God.


More and more people believed, became followers of Jesus, and were baptized.





Paul and his friends obeyed the Spirit and continued to travel on their journey.




One night while sleeping, Paul had a vision of a man from Macedonia standing and begging him saying, "come over to Macedonia and help us."



The next morning Paul, Timothy and Silas got ready at once to leave for Macedonia. Paul knew that God wanted them to go and preach the gospel to them.




So, Paul and his friends boarded a big boat to sail to Macedonia. Some of there friends came with them to the ship to tell them goodbye.






Paul sat down and began teaching the women about Jesus. The Lord opened Lydia's heart. She believed Paul's message and she and the members of her household were baptized.
