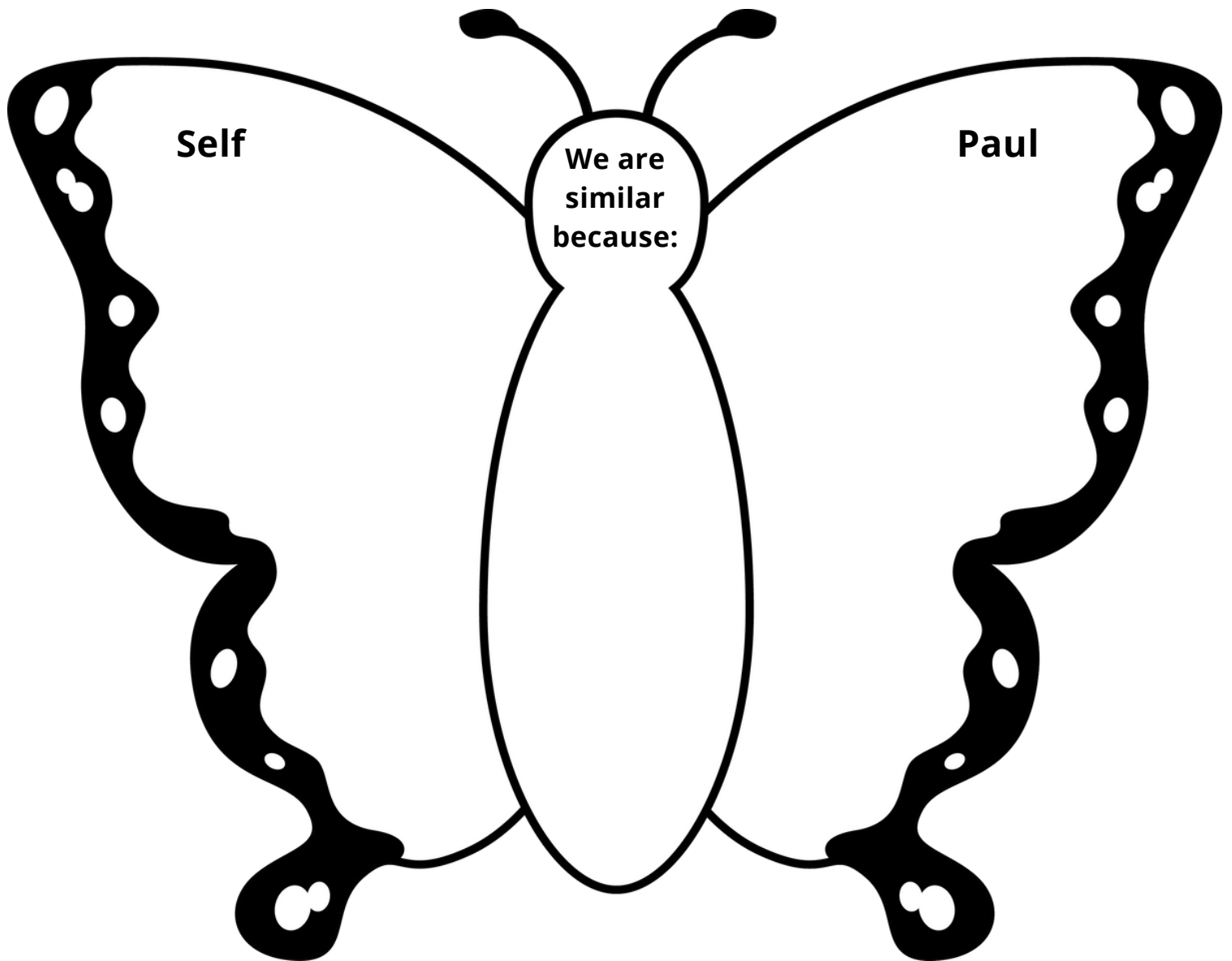




Butterfly Venn Diagram

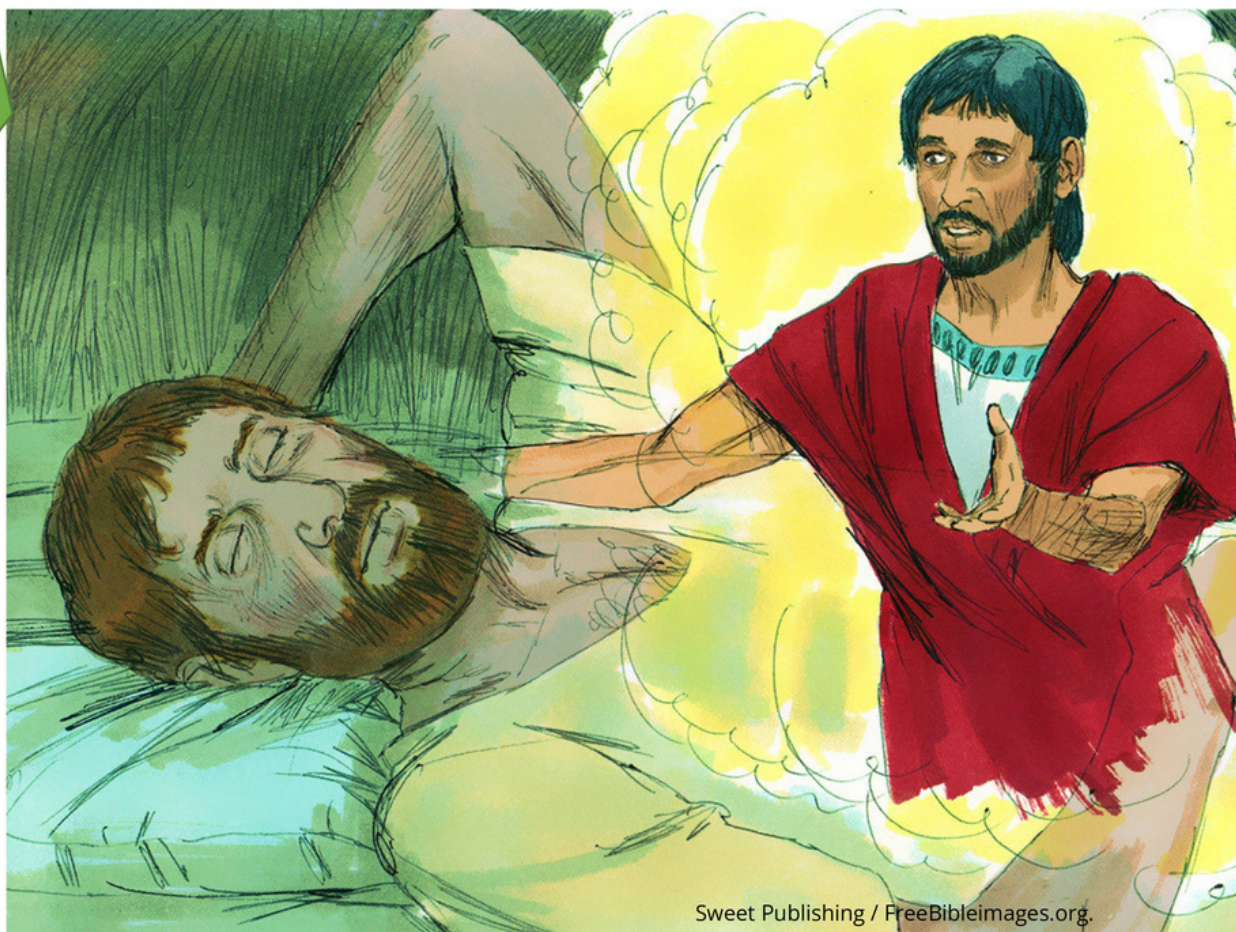

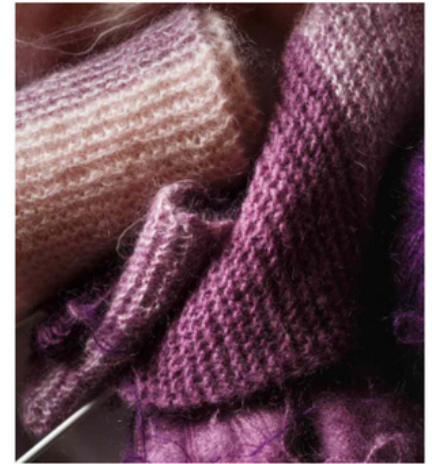
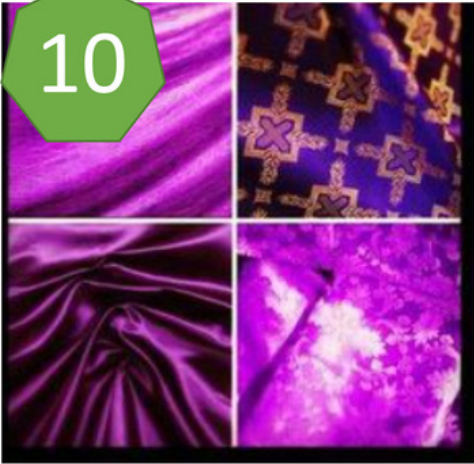
